THE HANOVER AREA MANAGEMENT ASSOCIATION, INC. 2022 CHARLES KIDDER (STUDENT) ESSAY CONTEST

THE SCHOLARSHIP

The Hanover Area Management Association, Inc., a non-profit organization, has established a \$1500* scholarship to help finance higher education for a traditional student of its member companies. The scholarship committee judges will select the winning essay. The decisions of the judges are final. The scholarship winner is announced April 2022, with the monetary award dispersed at the beginning of the fall term. The association reserves the right to present no awards or to split the award between equally qualified eligible recipients. Information is distributed to member companies, individual members, and local school guidance offices.

The scholarship is awarded without regard to race, color, creed, religion, sex, disability, or national origin or other protected category. The scholarship committee votes on numbered essays with all identifying individual information deleted. No member or officer will play a part in the selection if they have a relative entered in the contest.

*The amount of the scholarship is determined each year by the HAMA board of directors.

ELIGIBILITY: Contestants must be a traditional student who is planning to enroll in a full-time course of study at an accredited post-secondary education program (including a technical institution) in the fall of this year; and be a resident of South Central PA or Northern Maryland. Eligible contestants must also meet the following qualifications:

- ✓ The student must be employed, full or part time, at a HAMA member company, OR
- ✓ The student has a parent, step-parent, grandparent, legal guardian, or sibling who is an individual HAMA member or is employed at a HAMA member company.
- ✓ NOTE: If you have previously applied, you ARE eligible to apply again.

In addition, after the committee has selected the winning essay(s), the winner must show acceptance to an eligible college or technical school and show intent to attend no later than April 15, 2022. If the first-place winner defaults, the 2nd place winner will be awarded the scholarship, providing the same documentation is presented. The decision of the scholarship committee is final.

TOPIC

Contestant must submit an application which includes a minimum of 500 to maximum 1,000 words on the topic –

Discuss a challenge, set back, or failure that you encountered, how it affected you and what you learned from that experience.

RULES

Contestants must follow the Format Rules of this form to be eligible to win the essay contest. Contestants who do not follow the rules will be disqualified. Judges will use the selection criteria for judging entries.

DEADLINE

FORMAT RULES:

- ✓ A title page must be provided separately showing the author's name, current school, telephone number, home address, parent's/legal guardian's name, and parent's/legal guardian's (or contestant's) place of employment. The contestant should indicate his/her school guidance counselor's name (if applicable), planned field of study and if known, the school he/she plans to attend. (School finalization must be available by April 18 for contest winner)
- ✓ **Do NOT place identifying information** within the essay such as name, school, parent's name, etc.
- ✓ Essays should be submitted **without** staples, binders or covers for ease of copying.
- ✓ Essays must be submitted **typed**, **double spaced**, and **minimum 500 to maximum 1,000 words**.
- \checkmark Essays that are emailed must be submitted as an attached Microsoft Word document.
